Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2

EARLY MORNING EQUIPMENT DELIVERY

On Wednesday 5 and Monday 10 October an early morning delivery of a piling machine will occur from 2.00am, weather permitting. The piling machines will be delivered on a truck and trailer that is approximately 27 metres in length. Due to the length of the truck and trailer and limited space within the project corridor, temporary lane closures are required. Both entry and exit onto the Smith Street Motorway needs to occur when traffic volumes are at their lowest.



Work will involve:

- Temporary lane closure of the eastbound lanes on Smith Street Motorway near Biggera Creek and Uplands Drive.
- Traffic control to direct motorists during the lane closure.
- Temporary removal of concrete barriers to increase the width to allow truck and trailer access.
- Delivery truck and trailer enters into site and unloads the piling machine.
- Delivery truck and trailer exit the project corridor onto the Smith Street Motorway.

What to expect

- Delivery of piling machine into the project corridor.
- Noise from the mobile crane moving the concrete barriers, chains hitting the metal trailer during unloading activities, the piling machine engine and squeaking tracks whilst moving the unit off the trailer.
- Traffic control vehicles operating at two locations to place signage and close lanes.

Every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum for residents and road users. We appreciate your patience during these important works and will continue to update you as work progresses.
