Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2

TEMPORARY LANE CLOSURE FOR FOOTPATH REMOVAL



From the week commencing Monday 18 June 2018, CPB Contractors will commence removal of the temporary footpath along Greenacre Drive between Lucille Ball Place and Uplands Drive as part of the Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2. This work will require the closure of the westbound lane during construction hours for approximately 2 weeks, weather permitting.

Closure of the lane is required to ensure the safety of pedestrians, motorists and construction workers.

During the lane closure, two way traffic will be maintained under traffic control.

Works will involve:

- Temporary closure of the westbound lane on Greenacre Drive between Lucille Ball Place and Uplands Drive.
- Placement of temporary fencing around work area.
- Traffic control to direct motorists during construction works.
- Removal of temporary asphalt footpath and pram ramps.
- Laying of turf to reinstate the area.

What to expect

Construction work will occur between 7:00am and 6:00pm, Monday to Saturday. Workers may arrive onsite between 6.00am and 7.00am to prepare for the day's activities.

During construction, you may notice some changes around your local area such as:

- Increased levels of localised noise and dust from the use of machinery and equipment.
- Increased construction vehicle movements on local roads.
- Delivery of plant, materials and equipment.

Every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum for residents and road users. We appreciate your patience during these important works.
