### Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2

**G:LINK SERVICES TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED WHILE STAGE 2 IS ENERGISED.  
REPLACEMENT BUS SERVICES GOLD COAST UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL TO  
QUEEN STREET STATIONS**

**From midnight Friday 1 September until 5.00am Monday 4 September, work will be undertaken to connect Stage 1 with Stage 2 of the light rail at the Gold Coast University Hospital station.**

This work, to connect power and communication systems, will require the temporary shutdown of the light rail system between the Gold Coast University Hospital and Queen Street stations.

#### What to expect:

- **Light rail services will not operate between the Gold Coast University Hospital and Queen Street stations from midnight Friday 1 September until 5.00am Monday 4 September.**
- Buses will replace trams for travel between the Gold Coast University Hospital and Queen Street stations during this period.
- Once the connection is complete, Stage 2 will be energised, **meaning overhead electrical wires will be 'live' and should be treated with caution.**
- G:link passenger services between Helensvale and Gold Coast University Hospital stations will not occur until testing and commissioning is complete.

#### Replacement bus services

Light rail replacement buses will operate a loop service from night bus stops located adjacent to Queen Street station, Griffith University station and Gold Coast University Hospital station throughout the service suspension.

Bus replacements will be running on a similar frequency to the light rail timetable, however, delays may be experienced. Please allow extra time to travel on these two days.
