

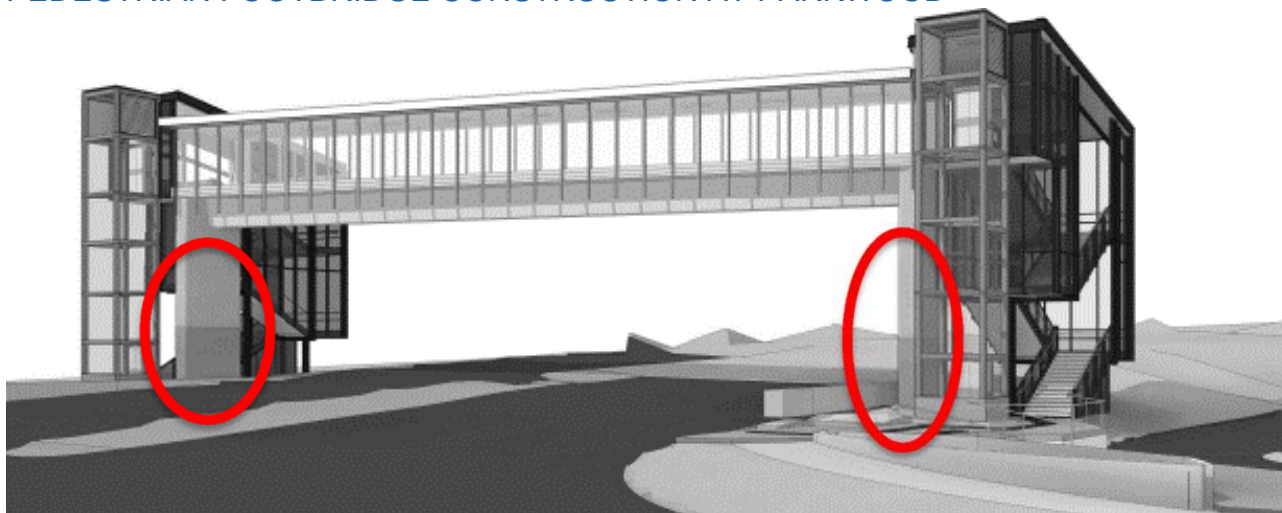

Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2

NIGHT WORKS – TEMPORARY EASTBOUND LANE CLOSURE SMITH STREET
PEDESTRIAN FOOTBRIDGE CONSTRUCTION AT PARKWOOD



As part of the construction of the Parkwood station pedestrian footbridge, night work will take place to install the main bridge supports on both sides of Smith Street on Tuesday, 17 October and Wednesday 18 October 2017 from 8:00pm to 5:00am.

This work must occur at night to allow for the prefabricated wall units to be delivered adjacent to the work area under a temporary eastbound lane closure on Smith Street. During the work, one eastbound lane will remain open to through traffic at all times.

Work will involve

- Delivery trucks will enter the work area to allow a mobile crane to lift the panels into place.
- Use of a 100 tonne crane, elevated working platform and concrete pump.
- Installation of the precast concrete panels.
- Timing of this work is subject to weather and site conditions.
- VMS electronic message boards advising motorists of changed lane conditions.

What to expect

- Single eastbound left-hand lane closure on Smith Street in the vicinity of the Napper Road intersection. One lane will remain open to through traffic at all times. Please drive to the conditions and follow traffic control and signage.
- During these works, you may notice some noise and vibration associated with the use of heavy machinery.

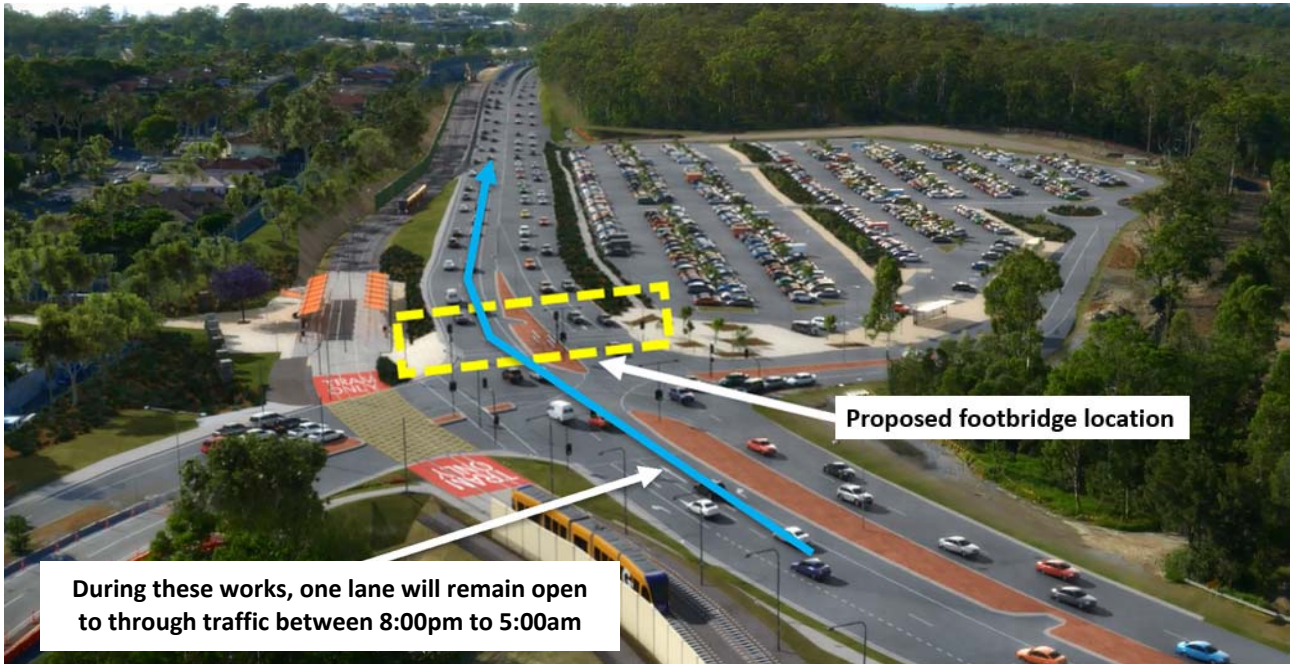
Every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum for residents and road users.

Pedestrian footbridge facts

- 44 metre long footbridge
- Full disability access with choice of using elevators or stairs
- 10 metre elevated structure
- Over 6 metres of road clearance
- Fully enclosed screen footbridge to prevent objects falling onto the road.
