Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2

GOLD COAST UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL (GCUH) - PLATFORM 2 RE-OPENING

From Thursday 9 November 2017, Platform 2 will re-open at Gold Coast University Hospital (GCUH) station.

With Stage 2 of the light rail between GCUH and Helensvale now in the testing and commissioning phase, trams will begin operating to the Stage 2 timetable from this time.

Services between GCUH and Broadbeach South will continue as normal. However, once at the GCUH, trams will enter into "Out of Service" mode and will continue north without passengers on board, as part of the rigorous testing phase. Southbound services will accept passengers from Platform 2 at GCUH station and will stop all stations to Broadbeach South.

This period will allow for the new Stage 2 timetable to be tested in preparation for passenger services in early 2018. Under the new timetable trams will run at the same frequency however the time of departure may change slightly.

Transferring to a bus? Check your connecting services by downloading the MyTransLink app, using the journey planner at translink.com.au or by calling 13 12 30 anytime.

What to expect:

- All southbound trams will leave from the re-opened Platform 2 on the hospital side of the station, and will stop all stations to Broadbeach South.
- When arriving at GCUH station please exit the tram as quickly as possible as the tram will need to switch to 'out of service' mode and continue its journey north to Helensvale.
- All passengers travelling south from GCUH station please use Platform 2 on the hospital side of the station to board the tram.
- When crossing at the mouth of the tunnel, please be sure to use the signalised pedestrian crossing. For your own safety, **do not** cross directly from platform to platform.

Please keep in mind that this is the beginning of an operational timetable. As such, there may occasionally be short delays as we learn the new timing points. We apologise for any inconvenience that may be caused and thank the Gold Coast community for their ongoing support.

To ensure your safety, please do not attempt to access the Stage 2 alignment while tram testing occurs. While stations may look complete, the area remains a construction zone and trams will not carry passengers north of the Gold Coast University Hospital until passenger operations commence in early 2018.
