Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2 involves the design and construction of a new 7.3km route which runs from Helensvale heavy rail station adjacent to the Gold Coast line, then adjacent to the Smith Street Motorway to connect with Stage 1 at the Gold Coast University Hospital light rail station.

GoldlinQ's construction contractor CPB Contractors, commenced construction in July 2016 and is committed to completing the project in time for the Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games.

Day Work

The following activities are planned during December, site conditions and weather permitting:

Location	Day Work
Napper Road and Smith Street	<p>Installation of the Parkwood station pedestrian footbridge - Temporary weekend road closure of Smith Street at Napper Road</p> <p>From 8:00pm Friday 8 December to 5:00am Monday 11 December 2017 the installation of the Parkwood footbridge and stairwells will occur spanning across Smith Street.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • During the footbridge and stairwell installation, Napper Road eastbound and southbound will be detoured due to the temporary closure of Smith Street. • Motorists should expect delays or seek an alternative route • Traffic control for lane closures, diversions and detours including signage will be in place to direct motorists. A detour map is available on the Stage 2 website. <p>More information is available at www.gclrstage2.com.au</p> <p>Parkwood park 'n' ride</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drainage, kerbing and asphaltting will continue at the future Parkwood park 'n' ride facility on Smith Street, opposite Napper Road.
Smith Street Motorway	<p>Temporary lane closures and speed reductions</p> <p>Temporary eastbound lane closures and speed reductions will continue until mid-December between 10.00am and 4.00pm weekdays (left lane only) to allow for finishing works on the side of the motorway and concrete barriers.</p> <p>NOTE: Night works are associated with this activity, see over for details.</p>
Various locations across the project	<p>Operational timetable testing</p> <p>During the day and night, tram movements will occur along the entire 7.3 kilometre alignment including the intersection at Olsen Avenue and Wintergreen Drive and at Napper Road and Smith Street, Parkwood. Remember to obey all signs, signals and road rules.</p> <p>To ensure your safety, please do not attempt to access the Stage 2 alignment while tram testing occurs. While stations may look complete, the area is still a construction zone and trams will not carry passengers north of the Gold Coast University Hospital until passenger services commence in early 2018.</p> <p>More information is available at www.gclrstage2.com.au</p> <p>Bus stop installation – Parkwood and Parkwood East stations</p> <p>The installation and upgrade of new bus stops at the front of Parkwood and Parkwood East stations is now underway on both Greenacre Drive and Henry Cotton Drive.</p> <p>This work is expected to continue until late December, weather and construction conditions permitting.</p> <p>More information is available at www.gclrstage2.com.au</p>

Night Work

The following work needs to be undertaken at night when traffic volumes are at their lowest, site conditions and weather permitting:

Location	Night Work
Smith Street and Smith Street Motorway	<p>Temporary lane closures and speed reductions</p> <p>Temporary eastbound lane closures and speed reductions on the Smith Street Motorway will continue until mid-December to allow for finishing works on the side of the motorway and concrete barriers.</p> <p>What to expect:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Intermittent temporary lane closures between and 8.00pm and 6.00am (two lanes as required) Sunday to Friday until mid-December. • During these works, the speed limit will be lowered to 60km/h for the safety of motorists and construction workers. Traffic control vehicles and signage to support the lane closures and speed reductions will be in place. • Motorists should expect delays or seek an alternative route.
Various locations across the project:	<p>Operational timetable testing</p> <p>Timetable testing of the light rail system will continue from the Gold Coast University Hospital station to Helensvale station.</p> <p>NOTE: Please refer to 'Day Work' section on page one for further details.</p> <p>Completion works</p> <p>During December night crews will be working across <u>all areas</u> of the alignment undertaking general maintenance and finishing works. Residents may experience some increased noise levels from machinery, including excavators and light vehicles.</p>
