# **Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2**

TEMPORARY SITE ACCESS - FALDO COURT, PARKWOOD



From Friday 19 May until late July 2017 a temporary site access will be established at Faldo Court, Parkwood to allow construction of the Parkwood East station and new pedestrian and cycle path running parallel to the Smith Street Motorway.

As ballast, sleepers and rail are gradually placed, construction access via the Smith Street Motorway will no longer be possible as completion works commence along the light rail corridor.

These works will enable the safe movement of construction vehicles in and out of site, while maintaining the current flow of traffic.

For the safety of motorists, pedestrians and construction workers, please observe all project signage and traffic control directions.

#### Work will involve:

- Installation of site access gates.
- Minor earthworks within the fence line to allow for vehicle access.
- Installation of construction signage.

#### What to expect:

- A minor increased number of construction vehicles on local roads including Parkwood Boulevard and Henry Cotton Drive.
- Construction vehicles may enter the site via Faldo Court from 6:45am to 6:00pm, Monday to Saturday.

Every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum. We appreciate your patience during this important work and will continue to update you as work progresses.

### **Project information**

Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2 involves the design and construction of a new 7.3km route which runs from Helensvale heavy rail station adjacent to the Gold Coast Line, then adjacent to the Smith Street Motorway to connect with Stage 1 at the Gold Coast University Hospital light rail station.

GoldlinQ's construction contractor CPB Contractors commenced construction in July 2016 and are committed to completing the project in time for the Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games.
