



Helensvale station

The new light rail station located at Helensvale will provide the main link between the Gold Coast light rail system and South East Queensland's passenger train network.

The existing station overpass will be extended providing an interchange between both heavy and light rail systems.

An architecturally designed plaza will provide 100 per cent cover for passengers moving between the light rail station platforms and heavy rail platforms.

The station will operate as an efficient interchange for daily commuters while also providing the capacity required for operation during major events such as the Gold Coast 600 and 2018 Gold Coast Commonwealth Games.

The light rail station design will provide a park 'n' ride facility with 400 vehicle parking spaces, kiss 'n' ride set down areas, taxi bay facilities, provision for motorcycles and accessible parking for people with disabilities.

A new premium bus stop, suitable for four buses to queue, will be placed within the new park 'n' ride facility.

FEATURES

Key features of the Helensvale station include:

- A new lift tower and raised pedestrian footbridge connecting Helensvale station and the new Gold Coast light rail.
- Centre island platform with passenger shelter and seating.
- CCTV security cameras and emergency help points on the station platforms are monitored 24/7.
- Passenger information displays on the platform.
- Bike racks for casual cycle storage, and a water bubbler.
- go card touch points at access points.
- Restroom facilities.

STATION ACCESSIBILITY

Helensvale station will provide accessibility features such as:

- An inclined ramp to the platform.
- Anti-slip surfaces, tactile ground surface indicators and hearing loops.
- Cross falls on the platform to prevent wheeled equipment, such as prams and wheelchairs from rolling towards the platform edge.





Stage 2 stations and alignment



Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2 involves the design and construction of a new 7.3km route which runs from Helensvale station on the Gold Coast line, then adjacent to the Smith Street Motorway to connect with Stage 1 at the Gold Coast University Hospital light rail station.

GoldLinQ and CPB Contractors have committed to completing the project in time for the Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games.
