



## Works Notification

### Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2

RELOCATION OF PUBLIC UTILITY SERVICES - OLSEN AVENUE / WINTERGREEN DRIVE



From early September 2016, work will commence at the intersection of Olsen Avenue and Wintergreen Drive in readiness for construction of the Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2. These works are expected to take several months to complete.

#### Works will involve:

- Intermittent night works at the intersection of Olsen Avenue and Wintergreen Drive – The majority of construction work in this area will be carried out between 8.00pm and 6.00am, Monday to Saturday to ensure minimal impacts on traffic
- Potholing and identification of services
- Public utility works, below and above ground, including service relocations and maintenance
- Safety fencing to contain the active work areas
- Saw cutting, excavation and road reconstruction
- Concrete works including installation of formwork, pouring and concrete cutting
- Temporary lane closures and changes to traffic flows and lanes will occur during these works. Please drive to the conditions and follow traffic control and signage at all times
- Pedestrian access will be maintained around the construction area
- Construction noise, dust and vibration at times. Every effort will be made to minimise these impacts
- Timing of this work is subject to weather conditions and construction constraints.

Any impacts to utility services, such as communications, electricity, water or gas, will be managed by the service/utility provider and you will be notified of any service disruptions in advance.

## Night work – relocation of public utility services

From September 2016, intermittent night work will occur at the intersection of Olsen Avenue and Wintergreen Drive to relocate public utility services to allow for the future construction of the light rail line. **This work will be undertaken between 8:00pm and 6:00am\*.**

These works must be undertaken at night when traffic volumes are at their lowest. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist and direct motorists.

### Night work will involve:

- Temporary lane closures on Olsen Avenue
- The use of light vehicles
- Using temporary lighting towers to light the work areas
- Traffic control by Queensland Police Service when required.

Every effort will be made to schedule the highest noise generating works to the earlier part of the evenings.

\*Should weather delay these activities, they will be undertaken on the next available night

Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 2 involves the design and construction of a new 7.3km route which runs from Helensvale heavy rail station adjacent to the Gold Coast Line, then adjacent to the Smith Street Motorway to connect with Stage 1 at the Gold Coast University Hospital light rail station.

GoldLinQ's construction contractor CPB Contractors commenced construction in July 2016 and are committed to completing the project in time for the Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games.



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
